Statutory Notice (10 U.S.C. §1044b)

***NOTICE.** This Power of Attorney is executed pursuant to 10 U.S.C. §1044b by a person authorized to receive legal assistance from the military services. Federal law exempts this document from any requirement of form, substance, formality, or recording that is prescribed for powers of attorney by the laws of a state, the District of Columbia, or a territory, commonwealth, or possession of the United States. Federal law specifies that this Power of Attorney shall be given the same legal effect as a power of attorney prepared and executed in accordance with the laws of the jurisdiction where it is presented.*

1. Designation of Agent

The Service Member appoints [AGENT NAME], of [AGENT ADDRESS], as attorney-in-fact (the "Agent").

2. Durability

This Power of Attorney is DURABLE and shall not be affected by the Service Member's later disability, incapacity, or absence on military duty.

3. Grant of Authority

The Service Member grants the Agent full authority to act in all matters, including: financial transactions; real and personal property; banking; receipt and disbursement of military pay and allowances; shipment and storage of household goods (HHG); on/off-post housing applications; tax returns; claims before the Department of Veterans Affairs and Servicemembers' Group Life Insurance (SGLI); TRICARE matters; vehicle title and registration; and all other matters necessary to protect the Service Member's interests during military service.

4. SCRA / USERRA Protections Preserved

Nothing herein waives any right or protection afforded under the **Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (50 U.S.C. §§3901 et seq.)** or **USERRA (38 U.S.C. §§4301 et seq.)**. The Agent shall invoke SCRA protections on the Service Member's behalf where applicable, including the 6% interest rate cap, stay of judicial and administrative proceedings, lease termination rights, and default judgment protections.

5. Execution by Military Legal Assistance Officer

This Instrument may be executed before any person authorized under **10 U.S.C. §1044a** to perform notarial acts (judge advocate; legal officer; adjutant, assistant adjutant, or acting adjutant; or civilian attorney serving as legal assistance counsel). **No seal is required** per 10 U.S.C. §1044a(c).

6. Compensation; Termination

No compensation; expenses only. Terminates on revocation, the Service Member's death, or accomplishment of purpose.
